



Professional Developer, Part-time

We are looking for a part-time professional developer to work on the Bridges to Academic Success team, a small team of coaches, professional developers, curriculum developers and researchers. We work to train teachers and administrators to support SIFE at the secondary level with developing literacy to implement the Bridges ELA curriculum and instructional methods.

The position requires both individual and collaborative work, both on site with teachers and in professional development workshops with the goal of supporting teachers to accelerate SIFE in both language and literacy. In addition, the position requires learning the Bridges curriculum design features in order to coach teachers in implementing and adapting the curriculum for their students. The professional developer will be responsible for designing and creating content as well as short videos to support teacher professional learning.

Finally, the position requires participation in collaborative meetings to review and discuss work plans and professional development materials. All coaches and professional developers are expected to keep logs of their work and debrief on a weekly or biweekly basis with their direct supervisor, who will also offer training and support. Other tasks will be discussed and designed as needed.

Qualifications

Required

- 3+ years experience working with and teaching English Language Learners, preferably SIFE and LL SIFE;
- Interest in and willingness to become familiar with our curriculum and instructional methods to both coach and participate in the design of professional development sessions;
- Ability to work collaboratively and independently to plan and facilitate professional development in both face to face and online sessions. Willingness to give and receive feedback on work and to revise in response to feedback
- Experience implementing language and literacy strategies in the secondary classroom
- Bilingual in Spanish or other language spoken by large populations of SIFE
- Ability to adapt to different school contexts
- Experience facilitating adult learning

- Experience designing and facilitating professional development sessions for teachers
